

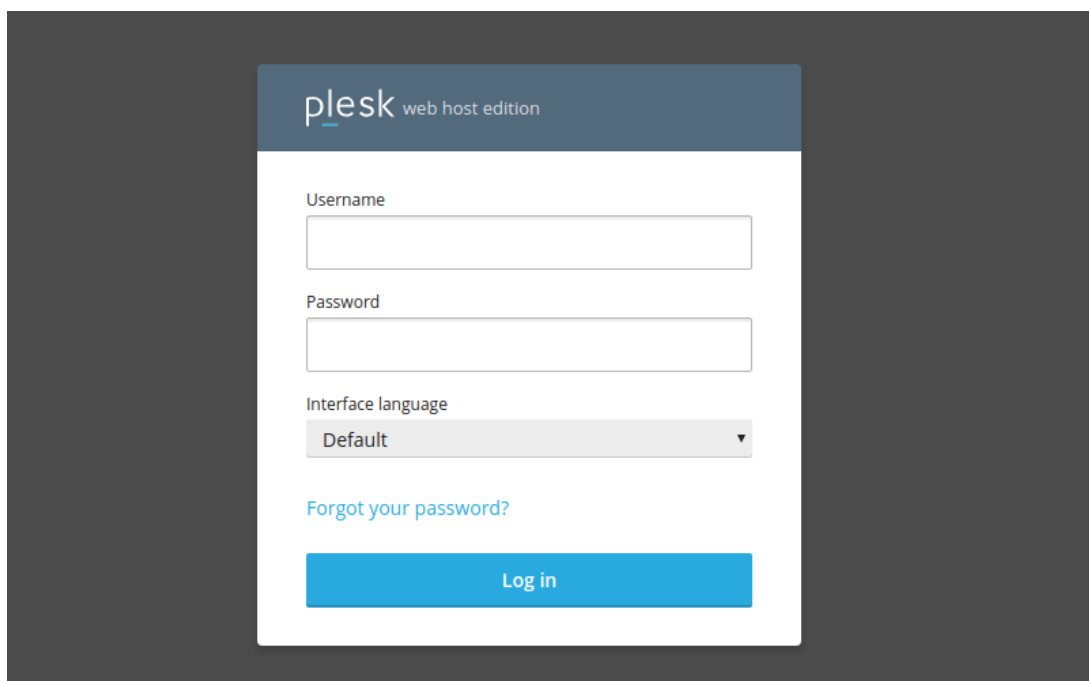



1. Συνδεθείτε στο **Plesk** με τα στοιχεία πρόσβασης σας.




2. Από την αριστερή λίστα επιλέξτε **Mail** και στη συνέχεια **Mail Settings**.
