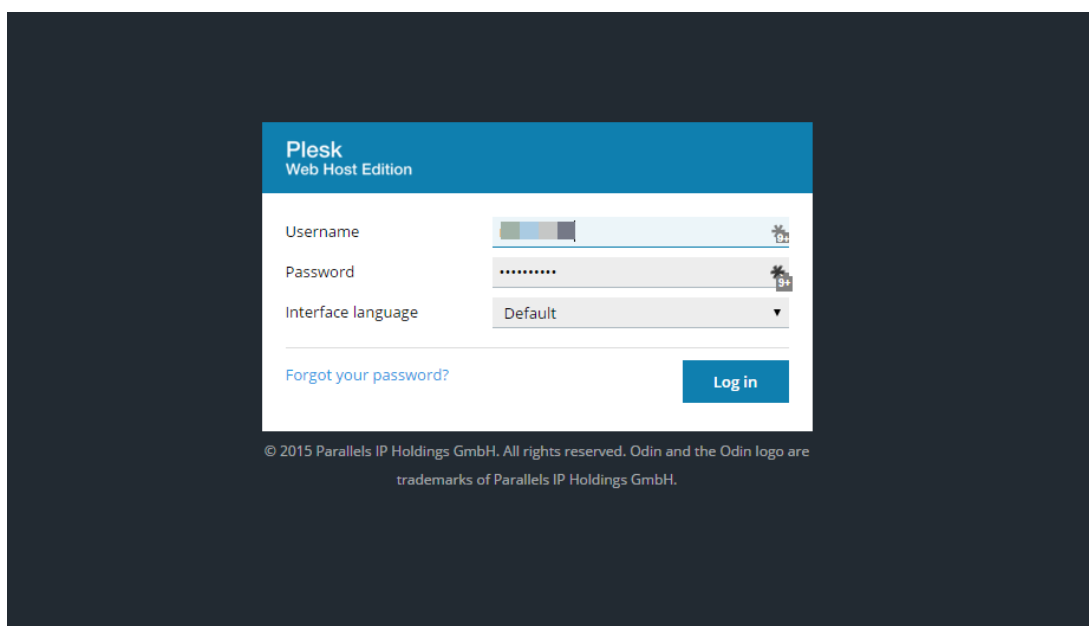


## How do I create a database in Plesk Onyx?

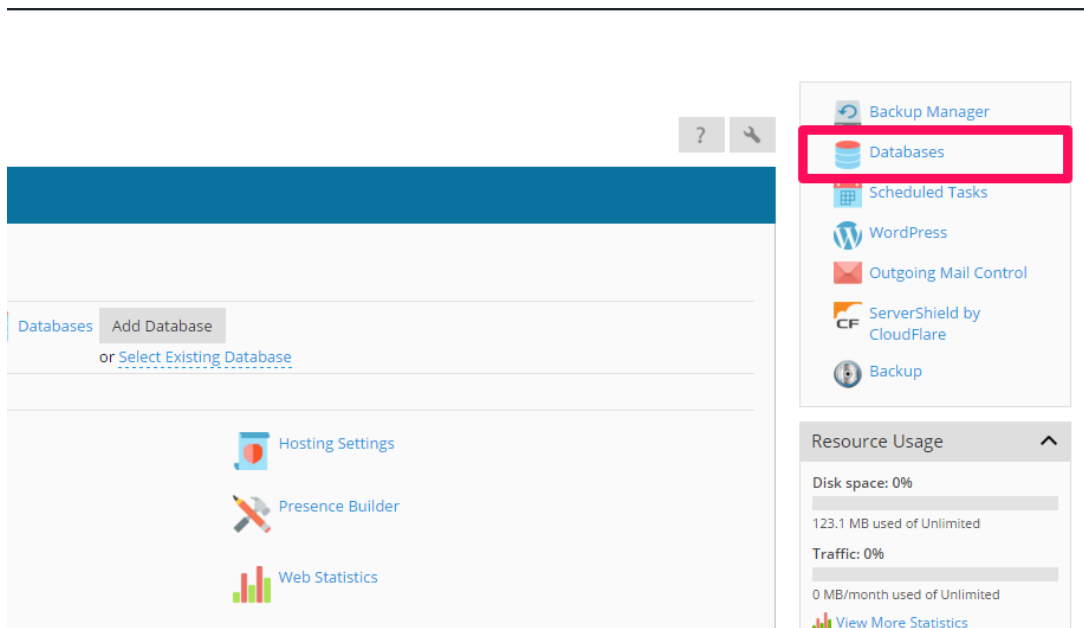

If you want to create a database in Plesk, follow the steps described below:

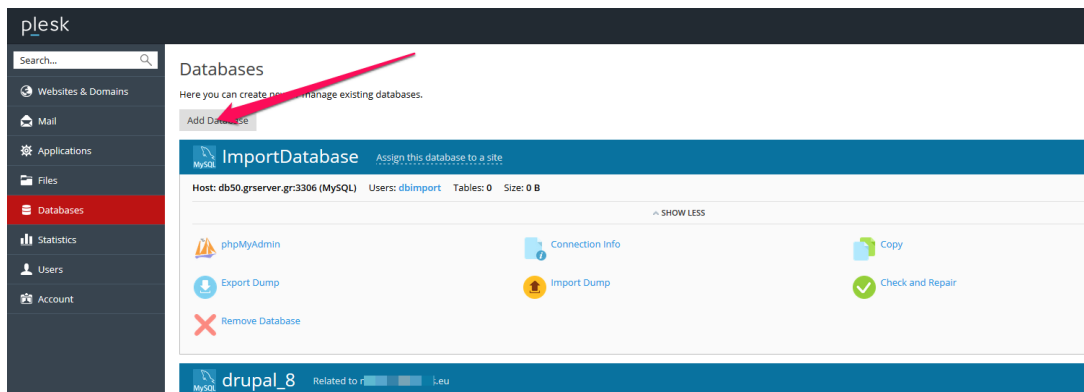
1. Log in to Plesk



2. Go to the tab Websites & Domains and click Databases





Users
