

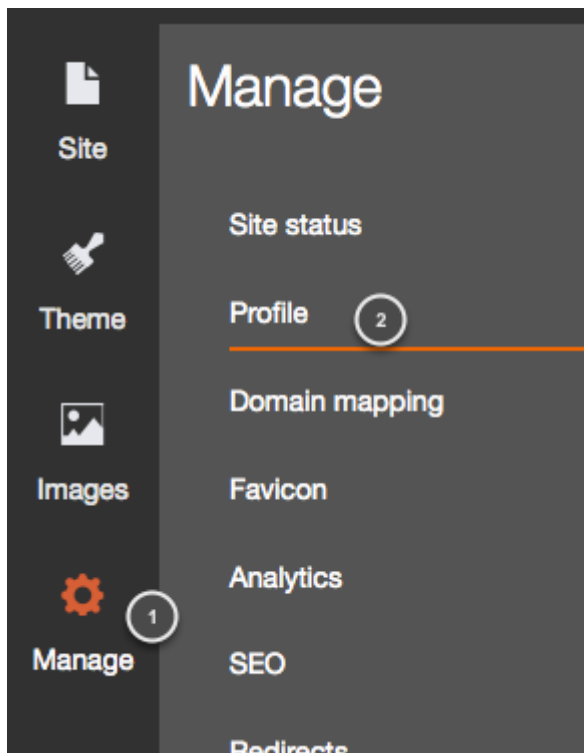
Setting up your profile

When you first create a website with the editor, it will offer the option to set your profile information. If you choose not to, you can add it later as shown below.

The Profile and Contact details will help you setting up your site easily by placing your information where it belongs across your website. You also can do this manually within your site, but it will take you longer to do so.


1. Click on the manage tab
